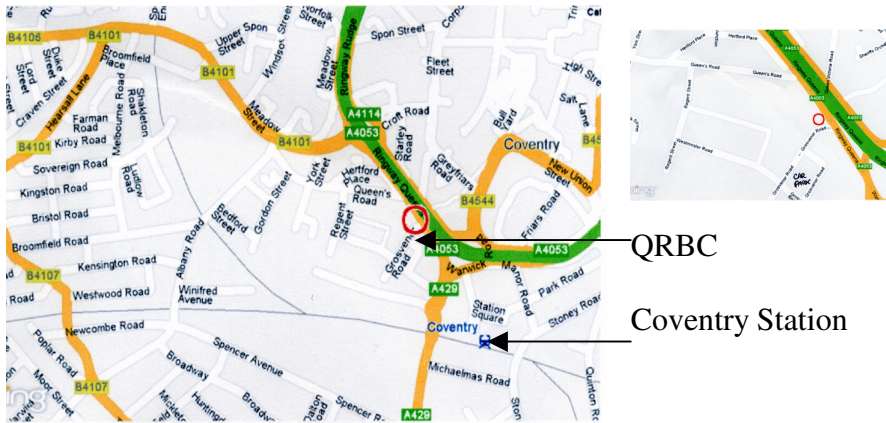

- Coventry is almost in the centre of the UK, a few miles east of Birmingham. To find us, approach the city centre by any major route. We are situated close to the centre of the city, adjacent to junction 6 of the city centre ring road - see map below.
- During the week the church car park can be accessed only from Grosvenor Road which is a one-way street accessible from the Ring Road (Ringway Queens) end.
- When using a Sat Nav please use CV1 3FZ this will bring you to Grosvenor Road
- At weekends and in the evenings, a further car park is available accessed from the turning circle at the end of Queens Road (next to Ringway Queens but not accessible from it).
- Queens Road is 5 minutes walk from Coventry Railway Station



Please note that this event is not suitable for children and there are no crèche facilities.

As well as providing places where people can come for prayer, the Mission also has a teaching and training ministry in churches of all denominations and John is usually out and about working in churches at weekends.
